Understanding Advent
The three comings of Christ

First, Christ came in history as the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies.

Second, Christ comes to us today through the Church and sacraments.

Third, Christ will come definitively at the end of time to judge and renew the world.

Scriptures use figurative language to signify that time will eventually be up and Christ will return. There's a deliberate tension—between promise and fulfillment, expectation and deliverance. This framework encourages us to look back, be present, and look forward, preparing our hearts for Jesus.

How can I be more watchful and vigilant in my daily life?

Lord, help us to be watchful and prayerful, to grow in love and holiness, and to trust in Your promises. Guide us through this Advent season as we prepare our hearts for the coming of Jesus. Amen.
